




COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT


ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

 - NEW METHANE STANDARD ADOPTED AT COP 28
 - HELPED GENERATE OVER 1 MILION PUBLIC COMMENTS ON SOOT POLLUTION AS EPA MAKES NEW RULES

- 30 MICORPS ADOPT-A-STREAM VOLUNTEERS SAMPLED & ASSESSED PLASTER CREEK AND BUCK CREEK WATERSHEDS (KENT CO.), RESULTS SHARED WITH MI EGLE
- OVER 40 RAIN BARRELS COLLECTING 500,000+ GALLONS OF RAINWATER - DISTRIBUTED IN GRAND RAPIDS, ROCKFORD, ADA VIA WMEAC'S RAIN BARREL WORKSHOPS


