## **Cedar Creek & Holton Township**

Residents of Cedar Creek and Holton Township can recycle at the Cedar Creek Township transfer station, located at 6871 Holton Duck Lake Road. The recycling center is open on **Saturdays from 8:30 AM to 3:00 PM** and accepts cardboard, coated cartons, glass bottles and jars, plastic bottles, jugs, and tubs, paper, magazines, metal cans, and aluminum foil. Fees vary by load size, starting at \$2 for a 20-gallon container. For details on fees and accepted items, visit [this link](#).

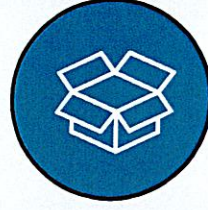
## **Dalton Township**

Dalton Township residents can recycle at the transfer station at 291 E. Michillinda Road, off Russell Road. The center operates on **Wednesdays and Saturdays from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM (April–October)** and **Saturdays from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM (November–March)**. Accepted recyclables include tin, glass jars, plastics #1–7, cardboard, office paper, junk mail, newspapers, and phone books. An annual recycling pass is available for \$30, or residents can purchase a \$15 punch card for five visits. ## **White Lake Area Solid Waste Authority Transfer Station**

(Residents of City of Whitehall, Whitehall Township, City of Montague, Montague Township, White River Township, and Blue Lake Township)

Residents of the City of Whitehall, Whitehall Township, City of Montague, Montague Township, White River Township, and Blue Lake Township can recycle at the transfer station at 2100 Holton Whitehall Road, Whitehall. The center is open on **Wednesdays and Saturdays from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM**. A 20-gallon bin of sorted recyclables costs \$3. More details are available by calling (231) 893-2405.

## **Ecology Station**

(Residents of Fruitland Township)

Fruitland Township residents can recycle at the Ecology Station. The center is open **Wednesdays from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM and Saturdays from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM (April–October)**, and **Saturdays from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM (November–March)**. Accepted recyclables include metal, plastic bottles, glass bottles and jars, paper, newspapers, phone books, magazines, and cardboard. Fees are \$2 for a 20-gallon bin and \$4 for a 40-gallon bin. ## **City of North Muskegon**

The City of North Muskegon permits several private vendors for recycling collection, including Ames Disposal, Chester's Sanitation, Kuerths Disposal, Republic Services, Solid Waste Solutions, and Waste Management. ## **City of North Muskegon**

## **City of Roosevelt Park**

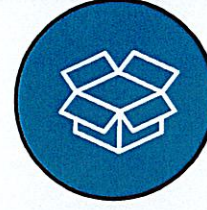
## **Village of Casnovia**
